

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025 (AMENDMENT NO 2)
(CASTONS CAR PARK) ORDER 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Hampshire in accordance with Section 39 (3) of the Act of 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2025 (Amendment No 2) (Castons Car Park) Order 2026.

The effect of the Order will be:-

To remove the permit parking provision from Castons Car Park, allowing all areas to be used as general pay and display parking places. It should be noted that alternative permit parking is available in the neighbouring Southern Road Car Park.

Date of Operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 8 August 2026.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 18 September 2026 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
