

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025 (AMENDMENT NO 3)  
(KINGS FURLONG CENTRE, THE WINKLE, BRIGHTON HILL PLAYING FIELDS, HEATHLANDS,  
NORMANTON ROAD, QUILTER ROAD AND TADLEY HEALTH AND FITNESS CENTRE CAR PARKS)  
ORDER 2026**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Hampshire in accordance with Section 39 (3) of the Act of 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, proposes to make the following Order:

**Title:-**

The title of the Order, if made, will be the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2025 (Amendment No 3) (Kings Furlong Centre, The Winkle, Brighton Hill Playing Fields, Heathlands, Normanton Road, Quilter Road and Tadley Health and Fitness Centre Car Parks) Order 2026

**The effect of the Order will be:-**

**Kings Furlong Centre** – To introduce Electric Vehicle parking places within this car park.

**The Winkle Car Park** – To introduce an Electric Vehicle parking place for disabled persons vehicles only.

**Brighton Hill Playing Fields and Heathlands Car Park, Penwood** - To introduce Electric Vehicle parking places within these car parks.

**Quilter Road** –To introduce Electric Vehicle parking places in this car park which will be restricted from 8am to 7pm 4 hours no return within 4 hours. The hours of 7pm to 8am are to remain unrestricted.

**Normanton Road** – To include this car park in the 2025 Order to formalise general parking, disabled persons parking and Electric Vehicle parking places

**Tadley Health and Fitness Centre Car Park** – to include this car park in the 2025 Order to formalise general parking, disabled parking and Electric Vehicle parking places.
